

8th Grade Service Form and Guidelines

As part of your preparation for the sacrament of Confirmation, and to help you build a sense of Christian community, you must complete *at least 20 hours* of community service by the end of April 2017. Community service can include, but is not limited to, volunteering for local charity organizations, helping out with parish or after school activities, safety patrol, and giving your time to other groups or organizations in the area that provide a worthy service to the community. Basically, if you're helping out someone who needs it (other than a family member), and you're not getting paid for it, it counts as service.

Use the form below and on the back to track your service hours. Have a volunteer coordinator, supervisor, teacher, or parent initial each record to verify that you have completed that activity. You may also turn in other forms that you may receive to verify service, but *you need to note them here. Please attach them to the back of this form.*

Some Guidelines: Any service performed after June 2016 can count (as in Vacation Bible School or the Parish Festival). Even if you have 20 hours of service for a single activity, you should participate in *at least* one additional event or activity. Students will have a variety of opportunities to complete some service here at the parish. Make sure to record these minutes as they happen. It is **your** responsibility to track your service. Note that altar serving and helping your family **do not** count toward service hours. Please ask Mr. Kersey or Mr. Waite if you have any questions.
